62.5%	Two children - single parent	53.0%
62.6%	Married family with two children at the poverty line	53.2%

Living in Georgia

In Georgia, single parents pay 34.7% of their income for center-based infant child care. Married parents of two children living at the poverty line pay 62.6% of their household income for center-based child care. The average price of center-based infant child care in Georgia is nearly the same as the average annual tuition and fees at a public four-year college or university.
