## Percent of Income Spent on Child Care

| Center |  | Home  |
|--------|--|-------|
| 13.8%  | Infant child care - married couple family            | 14.0% |
| 26.3%  | Two children - married couple family                 | 28.1% |
| 46.1%  | Infant child care - single parent                    | 46.8% |
| 87.9%  | Two children - single parent                         | 93.7% |
| 93.3%  | Married family with two children at the poverty line | 99.4% |

## Living in Nebraska

In Nebraska, single parents pay 46.1% of their income for center-based infant child care. Married parents of two children living at the poverty line pay 93.3% of their household income for center-based child care. The average price of center-based infant child care in Nebraska is more than the average annual tuition and fees at a public four-year college or university.
