Living in Virginia

In Virginia, single parents pay 48.2% of their income for center-based infant child care. The annual price of center-based child care for two children would cost a married-couple family living at or below the federal poverty line over 100% of annual household income. The average price of center-based infant care in Virginia is more than the average annual tuition and fees at a public four-year college or university.
