## Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Michigan the average price of child care is:




\$8,778 per year

\$13,458 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

## In Michigan:

- The median income for a married couple is \$99,959, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 14% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$28,086, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 48% of family income.








## Child Care vs. Household Expenses
