# Child Care Affordability in New Hampshire

### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In New Hampshire the average price of child care is:



\$10,028 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$10,015 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$14,245 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$13,151 per year

For a toddler in center-based child care


### Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.


#### In New Hampshire:

- The median income for a married couple is \$123,413, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 12% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$38,445, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 37% of family income.








## Child Care vs. Household Expenses

When compared to other household expenses, child care often has the highest price.
