#### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Pennsylvania the average price of child care is:



\$8,960 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$8,499 per year

For a toddler in family child care

\$12,152 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

**\$11,557** per year




### Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In Pennsylvania:

- The median income for a married couple is \$107,671, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 11% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$30,439, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 40% of family income.








# Child Care vs. Household Expenses
