The price of child care remains too high for many families.

\$16,307 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In Colorado:

- The median income for a married couple is \$119,080, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 16% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$39,633, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 49% of family income.








# Child Care vs. Household Expenses
