#### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Florida the average price of child care is:



\$9,360 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$8,320 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$11,440 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$9,880 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families

In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.


#### In Florida:

- The median income for a married couple is \$94,546, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 12% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$32,951, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 35% of family income.
