### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Minnesota the average price of child care is:



\$8,982 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$8,589 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$17,441 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$15,340 per year



## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In Minnesota:

- The median income for a married couple is \$127,103, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 14% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$38,874, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 45% of family income.








# Child Care vs. Household Expenses
