\$12,028 per year



In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.


In Nevada:


- The median income for a married couple is \$95,423, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 14% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$36,165, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 37% of family income.






A MARRIED COUPLE FAMILY
