#### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In North Carolina the average price of child care is:



\$9,375 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$9,045 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$11,833 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$11,209 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families

In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In North Carolina:


- The median income for a married couple is \$102,101, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 12% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$29,897, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 40% of family income.




