### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Washington the average price of child care is:



\$12,672 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$11,880 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$16,380 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$14,040 per year

For a toddler in center-based child care


### Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In Washington:

- The median income for a married couple is \$121,986, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 13% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$37,280, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 44% of family income.







## Child Care vs. Household Expenses

When compared to other household expenses, child care often has the highest price.
