## Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Arizona the average price of child care is:

**\$8,840 per year**

For an infant in family child care

**\$7,800 per year**

For a toddler in family child care



**\$14,040 per year**

For an infant in center-based child care

**\$12,662 per year**

For a toddler in center-based child care

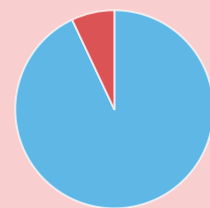


## Affordability of Child Care for Families

In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

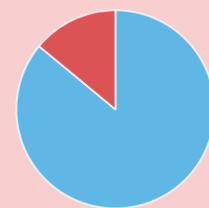
In Arizona:

- The median income for a married couple is **\$109,352**, which means center-based child care for an infant would use **12.8%** of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is **\$38,757**, which means center-based child care for an infant would use **36.2%** of family income.



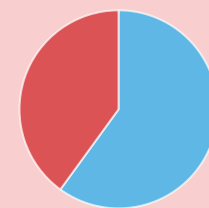

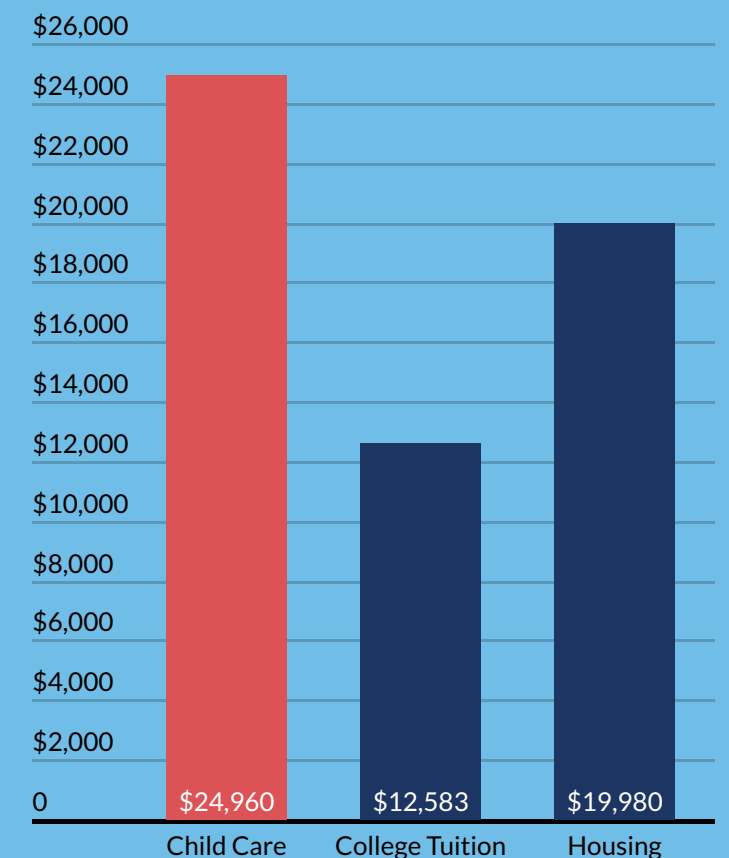
