\$23,431 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In District of Columbia:

- The median income for a married couple is \$244,272, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 10.4% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$40,328, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 63.2% of family income.








# Child Care vs. Household Expenses
