\$10,534 per year




Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

In Georgia:

- The median income for a married couple is \$114,214, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 9.7% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$34,904, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 31.7% of family income.








Child Care vs. Household Expenses
