### Child Care Affordability in North Carolina

#### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In North Carolina the average price of child care is:



\$9,617 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$9,160 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$12,251 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$11,363 per year




# Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In North Carolina:

- The median income for a married couple is \$111,537, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 11% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$32,626, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 37.5% of family income.








## Child Care vs. Household Expenses
