## Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Ohio the average price of child care is:



\$9,278 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$8,862 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$12,351 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$11,125 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

## In Ohio:

- The median income for a married couple is \$117,901, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 10.5% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$31,271, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 39.5% of family income.








## Child Care vs. Household Expenses
