#### **Annual Price of Child Care**

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Washington the average price of child care is:



\$15,600 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$14,300 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$20,370 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$17,976 per year



### Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.


#### In Washington:

- The median income for a married couple is \$134,049. which means center-based child care for an infant would use 15.2% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$41,994, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 48.5% of family income.




