Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In Nevada the average price of child care is:



\$9,703 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$9,239 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$12,659 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$11,442 per year




Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

In Nevada:

- The median income for a married couple is \$112,561, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 11% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$39,499, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 32% of family income.







Child Care vs. Household Expenses

When compared to other household expenses, child care often has the highest price.
