### Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In New Hampshire the average price of child care is:



\$11,708 per year

For an infant in family child care

\$11,432 per year

For a toddler in family child care



\$16,040 per year

For an infant in center-based child care

\$14,870 per year




## Affordability of Child Care for Families


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

#### In New Hampshire:

- The median income for a married couple is \$150,029, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 11% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$45,086, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 36% of family income.








#### \*Recent federal rule changes prohibit states from charging family copayments for subsidized care at more than 7% of household income
