## Annual Price of Child Care

The price of child care remains too high for many families.

In New York the average price of child care is:

**\$16,415 per year**

For an infant in family child care

**\$15,516 per year**

For a toddler in family child care

**\$20,439 per year**

For an infant in center-based child care

**\$18,661 per year**

For a toddler in center-based child care

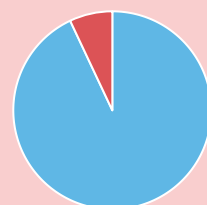


## Affordability of Child Care for Families

In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

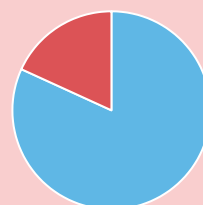
In New York:

- The median income for a married couple is **\$141,123**, which means center-based child care for an infant would use **14%** of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is **\$40,903**, which means center-based child care for an infant would use **50%** of family income.



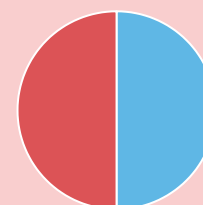

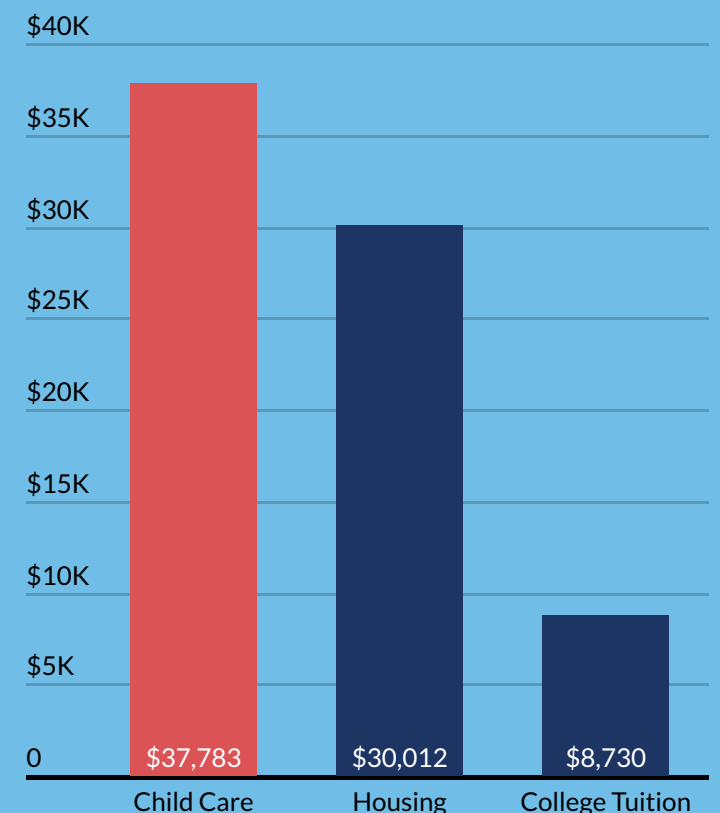
