In Ohio the average price of child care is:



\$10,556 per year

\$12,376 per year




Affordability of **Child Care for Families**


In all states, the price of child care in most settings, for most age groups, remains higher than what is considered affordable.

In Ohio:

- The median income for a married couple is \$124,688, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 11% of family income.
- The median income for a single parent family is \$34,414, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 40% of family income.
