
Child Care Affordability in MAINE

Child Care Aware of America's recent report **Demanding Change: Repairing our Child Care** System found that in 2020 in Maine:



In Maine, the median income for a single-parent family is \$30.138, which means center-based child care for an infant would use 36% of family median income.

In Maine, the median income for a married couple is \$94,782, which means center-based child for an infant would use of 11% of family median income.




In Maine, the average price of infant care in a center-based program is 1.08% more than the average tuition and fees at an in-state, four-year public university.



In Maine, the average price for two children in center-based child care is **102.79% more** than the average annualized rent cost and 23.73% **more** than the average annualized mortgage cost.
