



## Compared to tuition and housing...



In Minnesota, the average price of infant care in a center-based program is **42.15%** more than the average tuition and fees at an in-state, four-year public university.



In Minnesota, the average price for two children in center-based child care is 155.26% more than the average annualized rent cost and 57.84% more than the average annualized mortgage cost.
