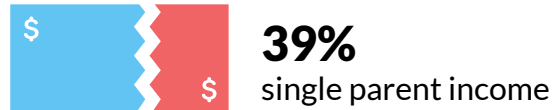


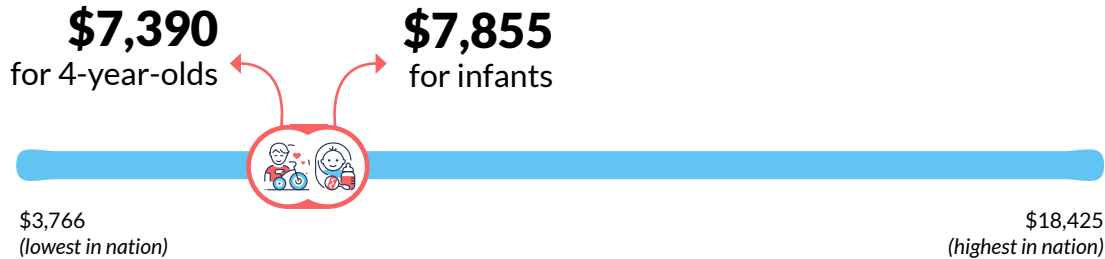
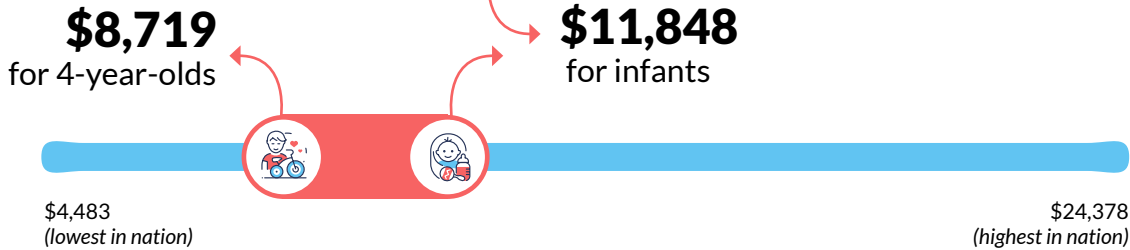
Child Care Affordability in ARIZONA

Child Care Aware of America's recent report Demanding Change: Repairing our Child Care System found that in 2020 in Arizona:

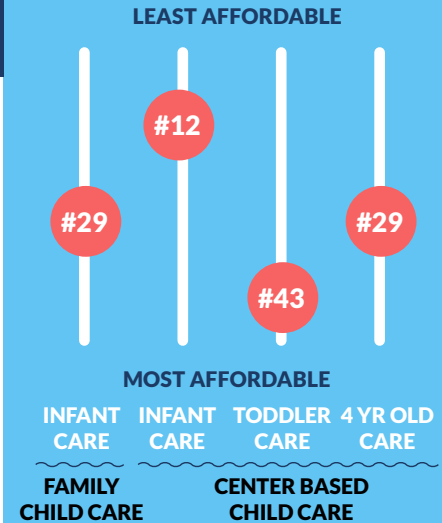
In Arizona, the median income for a single-parent family is \$30,416, which means center-based child care for an infant would use **39%** of family median income.



In Arizona, the median income for a married couple is \$88,352, which means center-based child for an infant would use **13%** of family median income.



When ranked among other states on the affordability of care:



Compared to tuition and housing...



In Arizona, the average price of infant care in a center-based program is **0.27% less** than the average tuition and fees at an in-state, four-year public university.



In Arizona, the average price for two children in center-based child care is **62.92% more** than the average annualized rent cost and **19.52% more** than the average annualized mortgage cost.
